Description / Outline:

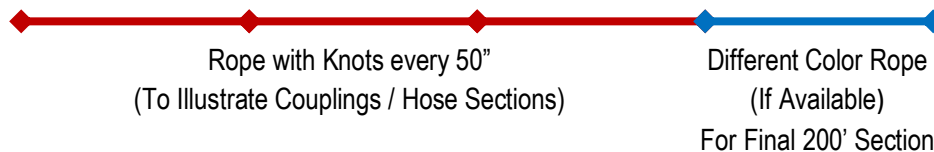
1. Hose Compliment of The Engine Company

- Will vary by Agency or Department
- Should be identified to efficiently serve the needs based on the response area

2. Review & Test The Ability To Correctly Estimate The Distance Of The Hose Stretch

- Build a “Drop Line” based on your Pre-Connect Configurations
 - Small Rope Bag or Plastic Jug (for Storage)
 - 150’ – 200’ of utility Line (Cheap Stuff from the Hardware Store works Great)
 - Quick-Clips or Carabiners
- Example for an Engine Co. with both 150’ & 200’ Pre-Connects

End with Quick-Clip
(To Attach to Apparatus)



- Now Go Out and Pick a few Buildings to Test-Out the New Tool

3. Perform Hose Evolutions To Demonstrate Correct Hose Selection, Placement, & Operation

- Estimate the Stretch, then Verify with Hose line Selection
- Operate Hose Lines
 - Proper Nozzle Position & Mechanics
 - Re-Inforce Coordination & Communication with the crew
