# DESCRIPTION

### **Objectives:**

- 1. Develop the resources and response requirements to fully support a 2-Alarm HR assignment.
- 2. To evaluate the changes to the Regional High Rise Response Policy and assess recommendations prior to the 2014 High Rise Drill:
  - Apparatus positioning and tandem-pumping evolutions •
  - Fire Attack deployment and sustainability
  - Staging / RIC location and equipment caches
  - RAT deployment and the ability to adequately pressurize stairwells
  - **OTIS** Elevator Control
- 3. Identify realistic expectations for the feasibility of completing these assignments:
  - Identify problematic Policies or procedures
  - Identify training deficiencies
  - Provide recommendations for developing solutions.

# **Description / Outline:**

Prior to the drills, Crews should review the Regional HR SOG.

#### Units will be dispatched as a full assignment to a simulated fire in a High Rise Building:

- 1. Units will be assigned as part of a full 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Alarm Assignment
- 2. Units will arrive on scene and receive assignments according to the Regional Response Policy or at the direction of the Incident Commander:
  - Systems, Lobby, OTIS
- Staging
- Fire Attack
- 2 Out / Back-Up
- Level II RIC
- Tandem Pumping
- RAT / Evacuation Group
- 3. At the completion of the exercise, crews will conduct a review to provide operational input.
