DESCRIPTION

Objectives:

The “Street Smart” Ground Ladders Drill will focus on fundamental fireground skills:

1. Review and perform the basic evolutions for spotting and raising the straight, extension, and roof ladders found on T45.
2. Review and demonstrate the options for carrying ladders and equipment.
3. Review and demonstrate the proper ladder placement to a building.
4. Review and demonstrate the options for working on a ladder.

Description / Outline:

Ladder Carries: To be performed with the 24’ Ext., 35’ Ext., & 20’ Str. Ladders

1. Options for removing ladders from Truck
2. Ladder carries / ladder drag – with Tools & Equipment
 - VES (Halligan, Hook)
 - Vent. (Roof Ladder, Saw, Hook)

Positioning Ladders: To be performed with the 24’ Ext., 35’ Ext., & 20’ Str. Ladders

1. Ladder for Ventilation
2. Ladder for Rescue
 - Placed at the Window Sill
 - Greatest angle that the Footing will support
3. Footing the Ladder (from the front)
4. Repositioning Ladders
 - Mud Lift
 - Ladder Roll

Working From a Ladder: To be performed with the 24’ Ext.

1. Modified Leg Locks
2. Arm Lock (With a tool)
