DESCRIPTION

Objectives:

- 1. Review the application & considerations of Vent-Enter-Search (VES or VEIS)
- 2. Demonstrate the techniques of Vent-Enter-(Isolate)-Search

Description / Outline:

- 1. VES or VE(I)S
 - The Tactic / Technique is essentially the same
 - ISOLATE (Shutting the door) has always been a component Emphasized as critical component in the modern fire environment.

2. Demonstrate VEIS Techniques

- Using the Training Facility / Building with Smoke Machine & Manneguin
 - Access Intended Search Area Or Room (Not Necessarily Directly Above The Fire Floor)
 - Tactic may be used to access high probability areas in Single Story Dwellings
 - 2. Clear The Window COMPLETELY
 - Remove the window, sash, and all window coverings (curtains or blinds)
 - 3. Sound / Sweep The Floor Immediately Inside The Window
 - Ensure that the floor surface is intact
 - Feel for potential occupants below window sill (under window furnishings)
 - 4. Enter The Room
 - Using Lowest Profile Possible
 - 2 FF method: 2nd firefighter may move to tip of ladder with TIC to direct search
 - 5. Move Directly To The Door And Isolate The Environment
 - Check area immediately outside of the door for victims
 - CLOSE THE DOOR
 - 6. Conduct A Rapid Search Of The Room
 - 7. Exit The Area And Move To Next Objective
