#### DESCRIPTION

### **Objectives:**

- 1. Review all required Water Rescue PPE (Inspection & Sizing) and/or limitations of equipment.
- 2. Demonstrate Water Rescue Awareness, including "Reach-Throw-GO" options

Additional Training Objectives May Be Modified Based On Department Specific Equipment & Operations:

- 3. Don Water Rescue PPE & Operate Equipment
- 4. Boat Operations

### **Description / Outline:**

- 1. Water Rescue Awareness
  - Required PPE: PFD within 10' of Dynamic Water (Helmet, Suit, Fins, etc. if Rescue Swimmer)
  - Capabilities and limitations of personnel & Department equipment

#### 2. "Reach - Throw - Go" Water Rescue

- Department Equipment & Personnel Qualifications (competency & comfort) may dictate the limiting factors of the Rescue
- REACH Tool Extended
- THROW Demonstrate Competency with Throw Bags
- GO Rescue Swimmer (Department Specific)
  - "Live Bait" PFD with Appropriate PPE
  - Launch, Swim, and Approach Victim
  - Victim Recovery
  - Recovery of Rescuer

#### Additional (Department Specific) Training:

- 3. Water Rescue PPE
  - Inspection and Maintenance Requirements
  - Correct Sizing & Donning Procedures
- 4. Boat Operations
  - Prepare to Launch & Launch Vessel
  - Navigation & Boat Operations
  - Casting & Recovering a Rescue Swimmer from the Boat
