DESCRIPTION

Objectives:

1. The training plan is designed to reintroduce some of the tools and techniques, used for the emergency and temporary leak stoppage of a liquid (primarily vehicle fuel), by the first-due company, to small holes in plastic and metal containers.
2. Review all proper PPE utilized on a Level-1 HAZMAT incident.
3. Review HAZMAT safety protocols and procedures for response to a Level-1 HAZMAT incident.
4. Review the Emergency Response Guidebook.
5. Review and utilize the tools used for plugging and patching of holes on plastic and metal containers.

Description / Outline:

1. Crews to discuss the PPE utilized on Level-1 Hazardous Material incidents.
 - Turnouts, boots, gloves, helmet, and respiratory protection (SCBA)
2. Crews to discuss the proper safety protocols and procedures for responses to Level-1 HAZMAT incident.
 - Scene safety, uphill/upwind, isolate/deny entry, proper notifications, request resources, etc...
 - Provide proper incident size-up and crews take actions based upon scope of training
3. Crews to discuss the Emergency Response Guidebook, the different colors within the ERG, and the means of navigating around the ERG.
4. Crews to discuss and then utilize the proper plugging and patching tools to plug the hole of a container.
 - Proper placement of wooden plugs, plug-&-dike, golf balls/footballs
